

digiKidz 2010 : Important Information

- 1). digiKidz is a co-ed technology camp offering four different program: (1) Digital film-making (2) Stop Motion Animation (3) Adobe Flash and (4) LEGO® Robotics.
- 2). digiKidz 2010 will run for 6 weeks : from July 5th - August 13th, 2010.
- 3). Each session is a week long and is limited to a maximum of 16 students.
- 4). Most sessions run for 5 days and are 1/2 day in length. Parents can choose a 1/2 days or a full day, by combining sessions.
- 5). Each 1/2 day week-long session is \$165. Family discounts are available for children in more than one session, or for siblings. 1 session: \$165, 2 sessions: \$275 and 3 sessions : \$380. If children attend a full day, lunchtime supervision is provided at no cost. NOTE: for week 5 only (August 3-6), 1/2 day session is \$120 and full day is \$220.
- 6). Junior LEGO Robotics and Motion and Junior Digital Experience are full day week long sessions, open to children ages 6-9 years of age only. The cost is \$220 and \$275 respectively.
- 7). All sessions are held in a classroom setting at the Sheridan College campus, located on Trafalgar Road, Oakville, Ontario. (Trafalgar Road and Upper Middle Road. See MAP).
- 8). Completed application forms must be accompanied by full payment in order to secure a place. All cheques are payable to digiKidz and mailed to 2323 Stone Glen Crescent, Oakville, Ontario, L6M 0C9. Payment can also be made by pay-pal to billing@digikidz.ca
- 9). Once full payment is received by digiKidz, an email confirming the placement is given. The placement is conditional on available space. digiKidz has the right to cancel any session at any time. Full refunds will be given to customers.
- 10). Children are expected to work collaboratively and to follow the Tribes Agreement of Mutual Respect and No Put Downs. Inappropriate behaviour contrary to the Tribes Agreement may result in a child being asked to leave. No refund will be given in this case. No refund is given for students who are absent for one or more days.
- 11). There are no prerequisites to take most sessions (except Advanced sessions). digiKidz provides all necessary equipment. Students are asked to bring in small props as part of their projects during the course of the camp and a USB memory stick to load their projects at the end of the Film-making, Animation and Flash sessions.
